



# Imaginary worlds



## English

Persuasive writing: Focusing on the text 'Zeraffa giraffe. The children will plan and write a persuasive guide for visiting Zeraffa at the Jardin des Plantes in Paris.

Fiction writing: focusing on the text 'When the Giant Stirred'. The children will write their own action story from a character's view point.

Looking closely at a range of imaginary worlds from books and films.

Geography: Map work - Using a map and coordinates.

Creating own imaginary characters and stories.

## Art:

3d sculptures: children will create their own creature for their imaginary world.  
Using brush strokes, prints and line drawings to portray dreams and imaginary worlds.
