Each year an estimated 40,000 hikers walk the WHW to admire it's dramatic and beautiful scenery and soon realise why The National Geographic lists it as one of the world's Top 10 trail walks.

We are delighted that Mr Smith is taking part in this walk and that he would like any sponsorship to go towards school. We are asking you to sponsor his

walk in the hopes that we can raise £1000 towards playtime enhancements.
