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Start of the day

A polite reminder that the school gates open at 08:45 and close at 09:00. Any children arriving from 09:00 onwards will need to enter the school via the main office. We do have some families arriving after 09:00 persistently. Please be aware of the impact that this has on your child's start to the day and the learning that is lost as a result is this is repeated over a period of time. The chart below highlights the impact of lateness over time within a school. Good Timekeeping means..

Making sure that your child is as school on time and ready to learn.

Did you know that fifteen minutes late each day is the same as missing two whole weeks of school?

On time each day	0 learning lost	
5 minutes late each day	3 days of learning lost	
10 minutes late each day	6.5 days of learning lost	
15 minutes late each day	10 days of learning lost	
20 minutes late each day	13 days of learning lost	
30 minutes late each day	19 days of learning lost
