

Key Stage Two Pupil Results 2016



Under the new assessment criteria, a score of 100 or more indicates that a child has met the expected standard for a Year 6 Child. A score of 110 or greater indicates that a child is working at a high standard. We are very pleased with our results in the first year of what is a very different system that cannot be compared with previous years. We are above the government floor standard in both progress and attainment measures. We are proud of our teachers and children who work so hard and also value greatly the continued support we have from parents/carers.
