Dear Parents and Carers,

Currently in school we have 16 confirmed COVID cases with many other children awaiting results. These cases are spread across the school with all classes bar EYFS having at least one positive case. Since September we have also had two staff members had to isolate following positive test results.

We are writing to request that parents remain extra vigilant for the main symptoms of COVID and also mindful of other symptoms which can often be displayed in children.

Main symptoms

The three main symptoms of COVID remain;

- A new continuous cough and / or
- A high temperature and / or
- A loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell.

Other symptoms

We have also noted other symptoms in children such as a **sore throat**, **itchy eyes**, **muscle aches**, **diarrhoea**, **headaches**, **nausea / vomiting and congestion / runny nose**.

Please note we have had several recent positive cases in children displaying no symptoms whatsoever.

We are therefore suggesting you consider taking your child for a PCR test if they are unwell with any of the above. It still remains the case that should your child display symptoms they should isolate (not attend school) and take a PCR and if they have had diarrhoea or sickness they do not attend school for 48 hours after their last bout.
