COVID in School

I am pleased to say that the cases of COVID in the Year 3, Year 5 and EYFS classes have reduced since they went over threshold. From of Monday the Year 3 and 5 returned to normal and we hope that this will be the case for the EYFS class by the end of the week.



We do still have several COVID-19 cases across school with higher cases currently in Year 4 and Year 6. These two classes are operating under additional measures.

We understand that you may find this concerning. However, it is recognised that education settings may meet the threshold from time to time and we are continuing to monitor the situation and work closely with the UK Health Security Agency and our local Outbreak Management Hub.

Play Equipment

Please can we remind parents that children should not be using the play equipment on either playground at the end of the day. We have noticed increasing numbers of children doing this without supervision. At the

end of the day the school staff are ensuring children are dismissed safely before dealing with any enquiries, clearing up and preparing for the next day. They are not on duty on either playground and are not present to supervise children using this equipment. It would be appreciated if parents can remind their children of this rule and ensure at the end of the day that their children are supervised

at collection. Your support with this matter is very much appreciated.
