Hydration

It is very easy to forget the importance of water for overall health and a well-

Punctuality

Please can we remind all parents that school drop off occurs between 08:45 and 09:00. **By 09:00 children should be in their classroom and ready for learning**. We are noticing a small but significant number of families who are routinely arriving after registration. This is not only disruptive for the office staff but means children are missing important teaching

<u>inputs and are disrupting others in their class when they arrive</u>. Arriving 5 minutes late per day, each day, means around 16 hours of learning is lost per year. This does have a significant impact on a child's learning development.

Use of Play equipment before and after school

As the evenings are becoming lighter and the temperatures increasing we are seeing an increasing number of parents loitering at the end of the school day. While some parents are chatting, their children are often left to play on the playground equipment unsupervised. Please can we remind parents that **children should not be using the play equipment on either playground at the end of the day**.

It would be appreciated if parents can remind their children of this rule and ensure at the end of the day that their children are supervised at collection. Your support with this matter is very much appreciated.
